Building fire alarm system is set off by pulling fire alarm pull station. Also, the alarm can be set off accidently by all the lightening.

When building fire alarm system goes off:

- 1. Check your unit and everyone in it to be sure everything and everyone is safe.
- 2. Call 911 and report the Oakridge V building fire alarm is sounding.
- 3. Exit your unit and carefully go down the stairs and across the parking lot to the recycle blue dumpster area until the fire department says the building is safe to re-enter.
 - Be very careful when opening your front door as neighbors, volunteers and fire department personal will be traveling on the catwalks.

If you see fire coming from any unit and the building fire alarm is not sounding:

- 1. Break the glass on the closest catwalk pull station to your unit and pull the alarm to set it off to warn your neighbors of the fire.
- 2. Call 911 and report the fire immediately.
- 3. Proceed immediately and carefully to parking area (see step 3 above).

Please under no circumstances touch the alarm horns in your bedrooms or attempt to disconnect them or attempt to turn off or disable any fire alarm equipment located anywhere in the building. The fire department will let us know when we are safe to re-enter the building.
